Re: NOTIFICATION – Traditional Deer Harvest at Clear Creek Forest Provincial Park

As the designated host community, the Eelunaapeewi Lahkeewiit (*Delaware Nation*) and Ontario Parks is notifying that the 2018 Deer Harvest will be held at Clear Creek Forest Provincial Park "ONLY" for this season.

The only allowable firearms are Shotguns (12 & 20 gauge, with slugs only) and any type of Bows (recurve, compound, and crossbow). In order to qualify with your chosen firearms, three shots must be within the specified target area (30 yards for Shotguns and 25 yards for Bows). See schedule below for qualifying dates, times and location.

Once the hunters have qualified their firearms and have identified their preferred dates at registration, they will be entered into a Sites Lottery Draw, scheduled to be held on November 19th at Moraviantown. All registered hunters will be notified once the Lottery Draw has been completed, either by cell phone text or email or both.

The scheduled dates are as follows:

- Nov 07th - 16th Registration dates - deadline closes at 4:00 p.m. on November 16, 2018
- Nov 17th & 18th Qualifying, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (at Darren Jacobs' place, Moraviantown)
- Nov 19th Lottery Draw for sites
- Nov 30th Opening Ceremony & first day of Deer Harvest
- Dec 01st Deer Harvest (full day hunt - one half hour before sunrise til one half hour after sunset)
- Dec 07th – 09th Deer Harvest (full day hunt - one half hour before sunrise til one half hour after sunset)
- Dec 13th & 14th Deer Harvest (full day hunt - one half hour before sunrise til one half hour after sunset)
